

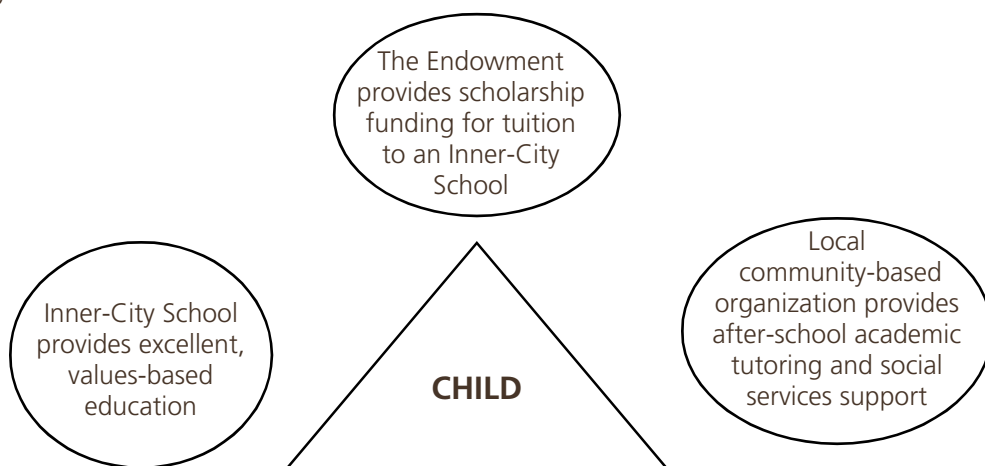

An Innovative Scholarship Program Created by The Endowment for Inner-City Education

- A full tuition scholarship program
- Provides a high-quality education to the lowest income children in New York City
- Average family income of students receiving scholarships is \$18,755
- Pairs an Inner-City Elementary School with enrollment capacity with a local community-based organization (CBO)
- Students receive robust academic after-school programming, mentorship and social services
- Parents contribute a small, reasonable monthly payment so they feel invested in their child's education
- For the 2007-2008 school year, the Endowment is supporting 72 students at 5 schools and hopes to expand the program each year
